# When the wells run dry.

Imagine trying to keep your family alive on a few cupfuls of dirty water from the bottom of a dried out hole. Impossible! But this is exactly the situation Julius (pictured below) and his family face.

Every day Julius joins dozens of other families queuing for water from a source that is running dry. All around them, in every direction, other communities are facing exactly the same situation.

First the rains failed. Then the harvest. Now war in Ukraine is causing food prices to spiral out of control. And people who live in this dry and dusty land are facing disaster. Their wells are running dry, their harvests have failed and they desperately need our help.

Please help people with disabilities get access to the food, water and medical supplies they need to survive this deadly drought.

Wells and water holes are drying up all over the country. Livestock are dying, their carcasses littering the landscape. How long before children follow?

People with disabilities are more likely to be seriously affected by increasing food prices and the decreasing availability of food and water. We're seeing increasing issues with malnutrition and families struggling with very limited access to markets and transportation.
